

# CINNAMINSON LACROSSE CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Cinnaminson Lacrosse Club has the goal of educating its participants in the ideals of good sportsmanship, integrity, honesty, leadership and teamwork through the teaching and supervision of the game of lacrosse. In so doing the Cinnaminson Lacrosse Club will contribute to the development of character, citizenship and physical fitness of our youth.

In order to carry out these goals and keep all participants focused on the recreational and educational nature of the Cinnaminson Lacrosse Club, we have adopted the following policy:

Sportsmanship and teaching concepts of fair play are essential to the game and must be taught at all levels and developed both at HOME and on the FIELD.

The value of good sportsmanship, the concepts of fair play, and the skills of the game should always be placed above winning.

The safety and welfare of the players are primary importance.

Players should always demonstrate positive behavior and respect toward teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators.

Spectators involved with the game must never permit anyone to openly or maliciously criticize badger, harass, or threaten an official, coach, player, or opponent.

Use of obscene or foul language, disputing or arguing a decision by an official or coach, excessive physical force on OR off the field, trash talking, baiting another player, defacing or damaging buildings, grounds or equipment are unacceptable and are not appropriate forms of sportsmanship.

Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in benching or suspension at the discretion of the coaches and the Cinnaminson Lacrosse Club administration.
